## Pop Up Prayer Space

This week, we have introduced the children to our new 'Pop Up Prayer Space'.

### **Why?**

Children and young people are innately curious about life. Growing up raises lots of questions, some to do with experiences (both the good and the bad) and some to do with their sense of wonder at the universe we live in and whether there's more to life than meets the eye. Many have an interest in the non-material aspects of life and want to explore how these ideas and experiences help them to develop their own sense of identity, self-worth, personal insight, meaning and purpose.

### **What is a prayer space?**

Prayer spaces in schools enable children and young people, of all faiths and none, to explore these life questions, spirituality and faith in a safe, creative and interactive way.

Taking a broadly Christian perspective as a starting point, prayer spaces give children and young people an opportunity to develop skills of personal reflection and to explore prayer in an open, inclusive and safe environment.

Prayer spaces offer a range of creative activities that encourage personal reflection on issues such as forgiveness, injustice, thankfulness, big questions, identity and stillness. The approach does not proselytise and purposely allows pupils to make their own meaning and to draw their own conclusions.

### **What?**

Our focus for the coming fortnight is 'In Honour Of...' where we are inviting children to honour someone they know (it may be someone who has left the area or someone who has died) by writing words of thanks and pegging them up in our prayer space.
