Dear parents/carers,

I am writing to inform you that we have received another call from a local resident regarding parking issues which occurred outside the school on Thursday at the end of the school day.

It was reported that three vehicles — a white Range Rover, a yellow pickup truck, and one other — were parked fully on the pavement. This caused significant concern, as pedestrians, including children, were forced to step into the road to pass safely. We have been informed that a photo of the vehicles will be emailed to the school. If it is confirmed that the vehicles were parked illegally, this image will be shared with the relevant authorities.

We must remind everyone once again that the safety of our children is our highest priority. Parking on pavements not only obstructs access but also puts lives at risk. We urge all parents and carers to think carefully about where and how they park their vehicles, especially during busy drop-off and pick-up times.

Please help us keep our school community safe by parking considerately and legally.
