



Frisby Collective Worship Plan – 2025-26

At Frisby, we have five acts of Collective Worship in a week, which are structured as follows:

- **Monday** – Whole school collective worship explores 'The Big Picture' through a current news story, encouraging children to consider its impact locally, nationally, and globally. These sessions are rooted in Christian values, helping children to reflect on what it means to be a responsible and caring **global citizen**. This approach is particularly important within our community, where children benefit from opportunities to broaden their **understanding of the wider world** and develop **empathy** for others beyond their immediate context. By linking real-world events to Christian teachings, we are equipping our pupils to engage thoughtfully with the **challenges** and **opportunities of modern life**.
- **Tuesday** – Class-based collective worship, inspired by a current news story introduced on Monday, is delivered in an age-appropriate way so that every child can relate to the content and **make personal connections**. Each session encourages children to reflect on how the themes relate to **Christian values** such as compassion, courage, forgiveness, and respect. Children are invited to record their thoughts and responses in a **reflection journal**, supporting their **spiritual development** and **moral understanding**.
- **Wednesday** – Whole school choral praise – a chance to use our voices to lift our spirits and join together as a **school family**.
- **Thursday** – Whole school worship (visitor-led where possible – member of clergy, Pastor, charity leader, or member of the community) who share messages rooted in Christian values, linking their work to themes such as compassion, justice, hope, and service. These sessions often offer a **spiritual dimension** that deepens our **understanding** and encourages **reflection** on how we live out our values in daily life.
- **Friday** – Picture Book Focus to share **representation** and **protected characteristics**. This CW also includes a whole school sharing of our children's gifts and talents and celebrating those who have **lived our school vision and values** during the week.

Sending - Dear God, **Thank you that we can always talk to you: Whoever we are, Wherever we are, Whatever we feel. Thank you that you hear what we say, And what we do not say. You know what we mean Even when we don't know ourselves. Amen.**

Week 2

Welcoming - Dear God, bless our school community. **Help us to be a place of respect and friendship where everyone feels valued. Amen.**

Sending –School vision so for Barlestone We walk in love, **just as Christ also loves us.**

Week 3

Welcoming - Loving God, thank you for our school and for all the people in it. **Help us to be kind, helpful, and understanding towards each other. Amen.**

Sending – Be kind and compassionate to one another – **Lord teach us to show kindness to everyone we meet today, Amen** (Be kind and compassionate to each other is a direct quote from the Bible from Ephesians 4:32, you would need to discuss this with pupils when introducing this prayer).

Week 4

Welcoming – Dear God, we light a candle as we gather together as a school. **Help us to listen carefully and think deeply as this new school day begins** (will need amending if worship is not at the start of the school day.

Sending – Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called Children of God. **God, make us peacemakers in our school and homes. Help us spread kindness and understanding, Amen** (Blessed are the peacemakers verse is from Matthew 5:9)

Appendix 2 – Welcoming and sending prayers that we have used before.

Sending – School vision so for Frisby

Week 2

Welcoming – A tiny light, a tiny prayer, for God's blessing everywhere (needs one candle, lit by the pupils as they start the prayer_

Sending – Go in peace, go in peace, go in joy, go in joy, go in love, go in love. Pupil say the first part, school community repeat.

Week 3

Welcoming - Father God, thank you for the light that Jesus brings to us and the light we can pass on to others. (needs one candle, one pupil lights and then passes to another pupil to put on the table/altar)

Sending – Father God, thank you that even when we cannot see you, you are still with us. May your invisible light shine brightly in and through us wherever we go in the days ahead (needs a real candle that is blown out, link is the smoke that dissipates as the prayer is said by all)

Week 4

Welcoming – Father God, thank you that you give us so much love that we can give away love to others without losing what we already have. (needs two candles, one pupils lights one and then uses that candle to light another one)

Sending – The Lords Prayer, we tried the modern version but none of the staff could say it correctly so we tend to use the old one!

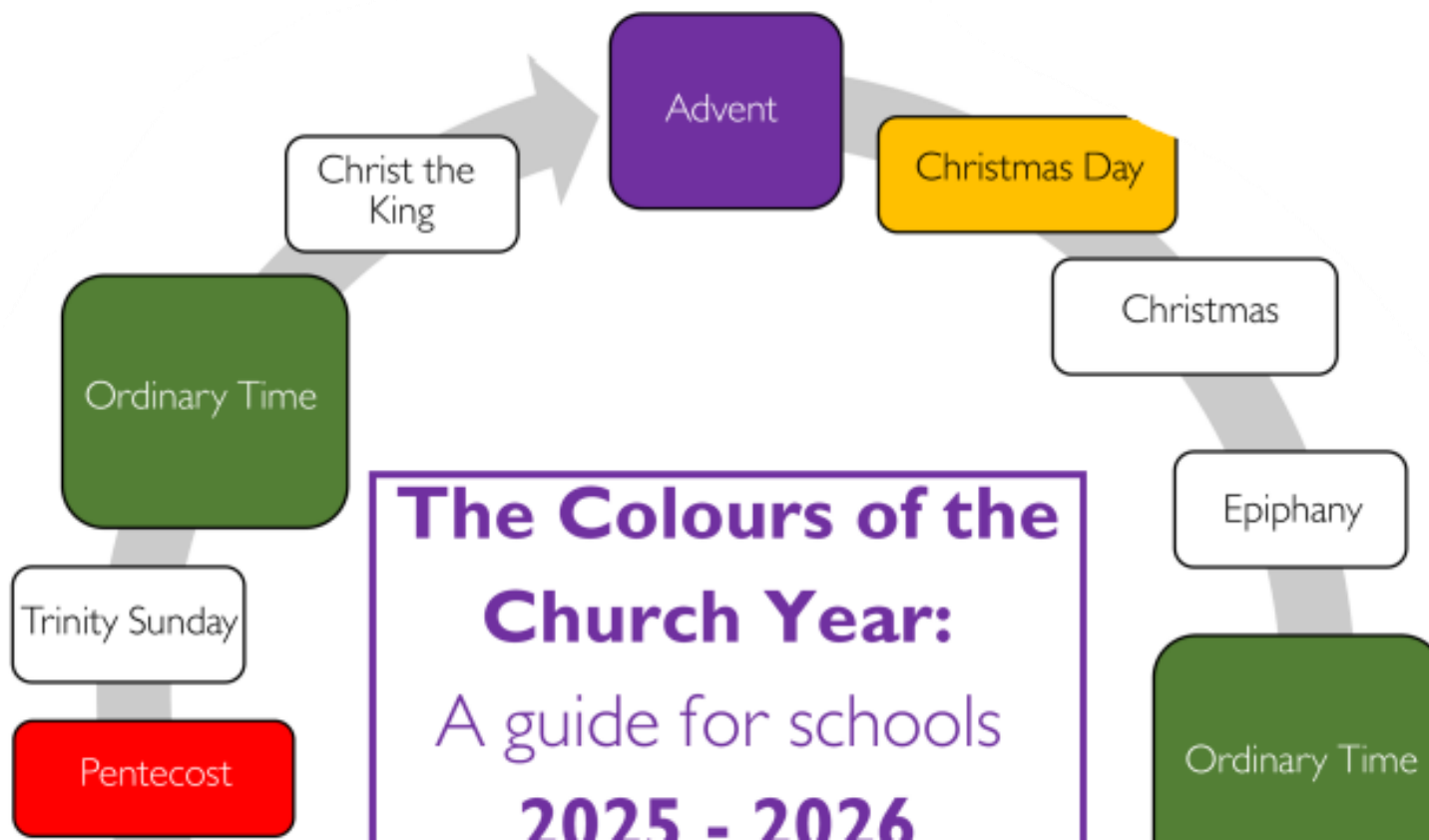

Appendix 4 – Liturgical Colours



The Anglican Church Year

Anglican churches follow a liturgical calendar. This provides a pattern (liturgy) for worship through the year. As a church school, this provides an ideal opportunity to mirror what is happening in your parish / local church. It also provides a colourful and visual way to mark the festivals throughout the year.

Most churches will use different coloured vestments (a priest's clothing) and altar cloths as signs of the season of the church year. In school, this can be mirrored through simply changing the colour of cloth on the worship table; or theme a whole display using the relevant colours. Soon you will find that the children recognise the colours and their meaning, that when they enter the worship space, they will notice the colours have changed and begin to make links between the seasons and the festivals throughout the year.

The meaning of the colours (dates are coloured on the attached calendar)

Green	Used during 'Ordinary time' between the main festivals and seasons. This covers most of the year and can represent growth.
Red	Used to either mark saints' days where it represents their death as a martyr, or to represent the flames of the Holy Spirit (for Pentecost / Whitsun).
White	Represents being pure, in celebrations such as baptisms, weddings, and some funerals. Also used for celebrations either on its own or with gold. It is also used for saints who did not die as martyrs.
Gold	Key celebrations, for example Christmas Day and Easter Sunday. Provision is also made for gold days to be dressed in white.
Purple	Used for times of preparation and waiting, the reflective seasons. Key times are Advent, Lent and occasionally funerals.
