

Class 1 – How Things Grow – Summer 1 – 2024/2025

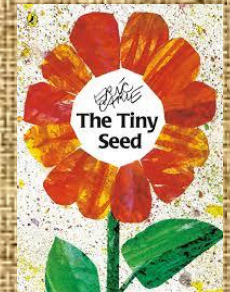
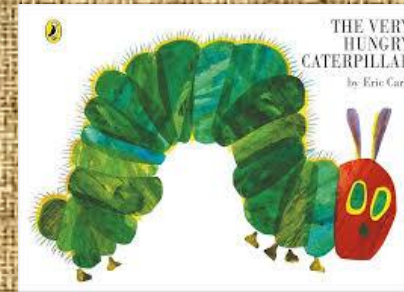
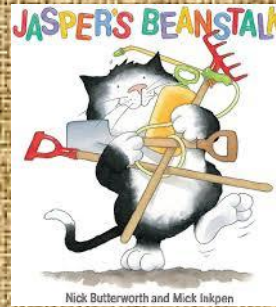
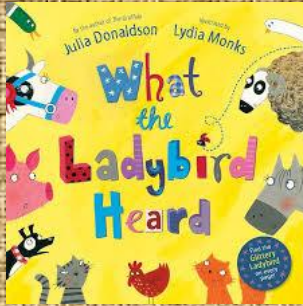
Literacy

The children will be using both fiction and non-fiction to learn about how things grow.

Phonics

This half term, the children will be recapping all sounds that have been previously taught this year. We will be concentrating on segmenting and blending skills, particularly with more complex words.

Maths

During this term, children will consolidate their counting skills, counting to larger numbers and developing a wider range of counting strategies. They will secure knowledge of number facts through varied practice.

EAD

The children will be learning about still life painting, collages and clay. We will be creating our own sunflower collages inspired by Vincent Van Gogh and making clay snails.



PSHE

We have a very important unit of work to cover during this half term. We will be teaching the children about: - Babies, childhood and adulthood - What do different families look like.

The children will be learning all about farm animals, minibeasts and growing plants. We will also have some very special visitors to our classroom which will support our learning of how things grow.
