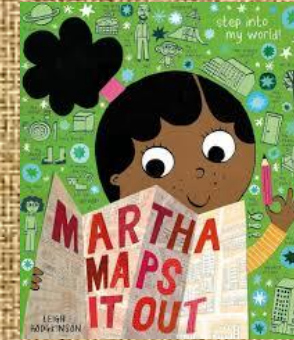
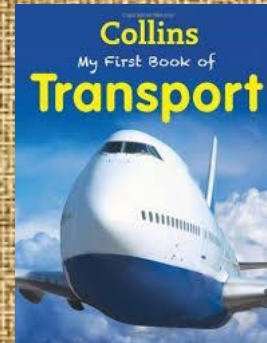
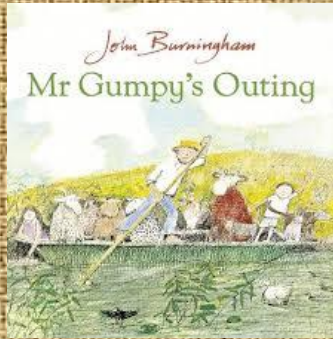
Literacy

The children will be using both fiction and non-fiction to learn about different modes of transport.

Phonics

This half term, the children will be recapping all sounds that have been previously taught this year. We will be concentrating on segmenting and blending skills, particularly with more complex words. Please continue to read regularly at home. If your child has already read their school book, please feel free to share any other book and not feel restricted to the book that we have given them.

Maths

Pupils will consolidate their counting skills, counting to larger numbers and developing a wider range of counting strategies. They will secure knowledge of number facts through varied practice. Pupils will continue to explore 2D and 3D shapes and build on their knowledge to visualise, build and map patterns.

EAD

The children will be designing and making their own boats from junk modelling. Then we will test the boats to see if they sink or float.

PSHE

This half term's PSHE topic 'Growing and Changing' incorporates Relationships and Health Education (RHE) and has been designed to cover key skills, attitudes and values children need to explore in order to develop healthy relationships with their peers.

PE

This half term the children are preparing for Sports Day. They will also be learning playground games.
